COHESION OF CONTEMPORARY ART AND FILM CULTURAL HERITAGE

Great success for the Workshop "Cohesion of Contemporary Art and Film Cultural Heritage", organized by the *Municipality of Termoli (Molise region)* at the Circolo della Vela, on 28 and 29 September 2022. The two days, dedicated to the restoration of the historical cinematographic heritage and to the enhancement of modern technologies and digital platforms for the recovery and cataloging of archival film material, saw the presence of a rich panel of experts and artists from Italy, Albania and Montenegro. Among the participants in the events, also the four artists selected by the project through an open call, launched last May, for a residential production of one documentary and one video installation. On this occasion the artists presented for the first time their cinematographic works, made using exclusively archival materials belonging to the film collections of Montenegrin Cinematheque and Albanian National Film Archive. The Workshop concluded with a dialogue session between the project partners and the stakeholders of the sector.





RECON-NETTING COHESION BETWEEN HISTORICAL FILM HERITAGE AND NEW FORMS OF ART

The historic setting of the Castello Svevo of Termoli hosted, on Friday 30 September 2022, the vernissage of the film exhibition "RECON-NETTING Cohesion between Historical Film Heritage and New forms of art", promoted and organized by the Municipality of Termoli. The exhibition, which took place from 1 October to 7 October 2022, allowed the young artists selected last May thanks to the open call launched by the Albanian and Montenegrin partners, to exhibit and screen their





cinematographic works: The Echo by Dario Haruni, Pse Kështu by Una Jovovic, A Poem a day keeps the war at bay by Tamara Pavicevic and Lemons and Oranges by Enxhi Noni.

The cinematographic works were made using archival material kept at the Albanian National Film Archive and the Montenegrin Cinematheque. The artists also presented a series of photographic images taken from the films realized.
